Directions

By car

Droitwich Spa Marina is easy to find. For those with sat nav our postcode is WR9 7DU. From Droitwich Spa Town Centre, take the B4090 Hanbury Road towards Alcester. After a series of mini islands, keeping the Droitwich canal in sight on your left, take the first left after going under the M5.

By rail

Disembark at Droitwich Spa station, then either call a cab (taxi firm at station's entrance) or enjoy a 25 minute walk along the towpath to the marina. (More details on request).

Introduction

Droitwich Spa Marina offers an exciting opportunity for narrow boat owners to moor their boats at this brand new 238 berth site, which opened in March 2012. The marina is set in the delightful Worcestershire countryside, adjacent to a large dairy farm and is family run.

Overview

We can provide a peaceful haven for you to relax and unwind, whilst providing a safe and secure environment for your boat. The marina has been designed not only to protect and enhance local wildlife and habitats, but also to give boaters all the modern services and facilities that would be expected of a state-of-the-art marina.

Canal restoration

Droitwich Spa Marina is located on the Droitwich Junction Canal which, together with the Droitwich Barge Canal, has recently been restored at a cost of £12.5m. This is the only stretch of canal to be restored from end to end in the last decade. The completion of these canals in July 2011 has opened a 21mile circular cruising ring, taking in the River Salwarpe, River Severn and the Worcester to Birmingham Canal.

Cruising ring

This new circuit will take approximately 20 hours of cruising time making it ideal to complete over a long weekend and is the shortest cruising ring in Europe. Using five different waterways, the new route not only passes through the picturesque town of Droitwich Spa with its many shops, pubs and cafes, but also encompasses the

historic Cathedral City of Worcester. The waterways are a short walk from Worcester Warriors Rugby Club, Worcester Cathedral, Royal Worcester Porcelain Museum, Worcester County Cricket Club and Worcester Racecourse, as well as an array of high street shops, restaurants and cinemas. There are also various other cruising opportunities on canals and rivers across the Midlands.

Location

Droitwich Spa Marina is in the perfect location for cruising the Midland waterways, plus is in an excellent location for exploring the local area on foot. Once moored, you are just a 15 minute stroll along the towpath to Droitwich Spa Town Centre (and not much further to Droitwich Spa Railway station), or just 200m walk to the junction of the Worcester to Birmingham canal and the Eagle and Sun pub. There are a variety of picturesque walks across the countryside to local attractions such as Hanbury Hall, a National Trust property.

By car, we are just 2 miles from Junction 5 of the M5, and our Midlands location means that we are easily accessible from any part of the country.
